To Samuel T. Dana, Land Agent and Forest Commissioner
Re: Water Power on Public Lots

Replying to your inquiry about the sale or lease of the water power on the public lot in Township 6, Range 7, W. E. L. S., it will be necessary for you to have legislative authority in such a case. The law gives you the right to sell and cut timber and grass and to do certain other things, but not the right to sell or lease power or power rights.
