To Honorable Percival P. Baxter, Governor of Maine  
Re: Women as Normal School Trustees

Replying to your question about the qualification of the Normal School trustees, I wish to say that women are eligible to the position.

Chapter 267 of the Special Session of the legislature of 1920 provided for the holding of civil offices by women and this was held to be constitutional by the Justices March 9, 1921 (119 Maine 603).

The number to be appointed by the Governor is four and not more than two shall be of the same political faith. . .
