To Farm Lands Loan Commission  
Re: Right to Sell Property Taken on Foreclosures

This department has been asked concerning the conveyance of certain property situate in the town of Connor, in Aroostook County, which has come into the possession of the State by reason of foreclosure of a certain mortgage.

We do not find any provisions of statute which give the Commission any power to convey the land in question, neither do we find any provisions of statute whereby either the Land Agent or the Governor and Council can make a conveyance. It is our opinion that an act of the legislature will be necessary in order to make conveyance of this property.
