To State Highway Commission
Re: Permits for Moving Buildings

Answering your letter of October 24th, regarding permits for moving buildings, I would call your attention to Section 18 of Chapter 211, Public Laws of 1921, which I think answers your inquiry.

Under this section, it seems to be provided that the Highway Commission grant the permits over any way or bridge upon which money of the State has been expended or over which the Commission has assumed control. County and municipal officers grant permits over all other roads.
