To Elbert D. Hayford, State Auditor
Re: Cash Registers on Toll Bridge.

Answering your recent oral inquiry as to whether or not the cash registers which have been purchased in connection with the operation of the Kennebec Bridge should be charged against the bond issue for construction, I beg to inform you that it is my opinion that these registers are not in fact a part of the bridge, but are in the nature of equipment which have been decided upon in connection with the bridge operation.

It has been held that,

"Construction and equipment are separate and distinct features and the one does not embrace the other."
