To Clarence F. Kendall, M. D., Commissioner of Health  
Re: Local Ordinances, etc., Plumbing

I do not believe that the criminal penalty imposed by R. S. Chapter 19, Section 115, applies to selectmen or other town officers of a town which has failed to prescribe sewerage and water supply regulations as required by Section 112 of the same chapter.

I do not believe our Legislature intended to fine a municipal corporation under this section, and certainly the officers of the municipality would not be responsible for the failure of the town to pass an ordinance.
