To State Highway Commission Re: Lighting of Underpass

Answering your inquiry of December 20 with reference to the lighting of Death Underpass, I do not know of any provision of statute which makes provision for lighting such a portion of the highway.

In case the Commission should decide that the safety of the traveling public requires that this underpass be lighted, it is probable that they might provide necessary lights on the ground that it is necessary in order to keep the highway reasonably safe, and charge the expense of the same to maintenance. . .
