To State Highway Commission
Re: Construction of Androscoggin Bridge at Brunswick

Mr. Wilder, your Bridge Engineer, talked with me informally this morning about the construction of this bridge, especially with reference to the financial arrangements with the Town of Brunswick which appear to be necessary in order to expedite construction.

I do not know of any reason why the Commission are not justified in having an understanding with the town that the town shall be reimbursed for a portion of the expense incurred in securing the necessary approach to the bridge on the Brunswick end thereof out of State funds at such time as may be deemed advisable.
