To State Highway Commission  
Re: Change of Designation of State Aid Highway

The town of Waterboro at its annual meeting had an article in its town warrant,-

"To see what sum of money the town will grant and raise in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 154 of the Public Laws of 1917, as amended, for the construction of a State Aid highway designated as State Aid Road Number 3."

Under this article the Town voted the sum of \$2,665.00.

It is now desired that the money appropriated as aforesaid may be expended on State Road Number 215, extending from East Waterboro to the Lyman line, instead of on State Aid Road Number 3.

It is the opinion of this department that the town may, if it so desires, change the designation of the State Aid highway on which said money shall be expended by a majority vote at a special meeting called for that purpose, so that the money may be expended on State Road Number 205.
