To State Highway Commission

Re: Maintenance of Roads Reverting to Towns or Counties

Answering your inquiry regarding the change of location of the county and town roads, I have to inform you that my understanding is that your change of the location of the State highway does not discontinue or affect the location of the county or town way. After such location or relocation of the State highway my understanding is that the burden of maintaining the roads you have abandoned is on the town or the county.

This burden evidently will remain until such time as the way is discontinued.
