To Dr. Elmer W. Campbell, Director of Sanitary Engineering
Re: Fixtures

. . . I have no doubt but that "fixtures" within the meaning of P. L. 1931, Chapter 235, Section 121A, includes sinks installed in laboratories draining at one end through connections to the sewer, and also individual sinks in laboratories individually connected to drains which come together and empty into the draining system.

The object of the statute appears to be to include within the word "fixtures" any receptacle which discharges liquid into a drainage system.
