Re: Temporary Loan

Answering your inquiry as to the legality of the two notes, each in the amount of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000), issued by the State of Maine, dated January 2, 1933, due March 2, 1933, this department makes the following reply:

These notes are issued on account of a Temporary Loan in anticipation of taxes of 1932 by the authorization of an Order passed by the Council and by the Governor approved, on December 28, 1932, as is more fully set forth in a certified copy of said Order which is hereto annexed.

This Order authorized the Commissioner of the Treasury to negotiate the aforesaid loan.
