Gentlemen:

Replying to your letter of May 1, concerning the Sunday amateur sports' law, I beg to suggest that in my opinion it is not proper for a town to vote upon the question of Sunday sports until the law passed at the last legislature becomes effective. As I construe that law the question to be submitted to the voters concerns the attitude they shall then have about allowing Sunday sports, and the law is not concerned with what their attitude was a year before, a month before, or even a day before the law becomes effective.
