Dear Sir:

Replying to your letter of May 3, signed by the three members of your board and concerning the vote of your town, making it optional with the assessors whether they assess the entire amount of the town's appropriation or not, I beg to advise that in my opinion the duty of the assessors is to assess the entire amount of the appropriation, and that any attempt on the part of the town to delegate them additional authority was of no avail. Accordingly, the Board of Assessors should assess the entire amount the Town of Bar Harbor voted.
