In response to your letter of the state of pleased to inform you that Chipty 137 of the Public Laws of 1933 evidently provide that the State shall maintain bridges and approvides the public on hickneys.

Chapter 95 of the Suble Laws of 1931 provided

improvement a main cance all bridges on state highways and approches thereto, shall be borne while by the true except in the case of bridges that lie within the compact portion of an any or own of we ten thousand inhabitance.

This Act as been generally construed to include bridges and approaches thereto. The word "approaches" evidently refers to in word "bridges" and not to the words "state eighways. If it referred to and included approaches to a lighways, it might be held to include practically and to bridges in the State of Baine.
