Re: Temporary Loan

Gentlemen:

Answering your inquiry as to the legality of Fifty-four (54) notes aggregating Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$800,000) issued by the State of Maine, dated August 7, 1933, payable Februrary 7, 1934, this department makes the following reply:

These notes are issued on account of a Temporary Loan in anticipation of taxes by authorization of an Order passed by the Council and by the Governor approved on the Seventh day of Augusta, 1933.

The issuance of these notes, being authorized by law and all proceedings in connection therewith being regular, is legal and is a pledge of the faith and credit and a legal debt of the State of Maine.
