Dear Brother Downs:

In response to your letter of August 3 it seems to me that the deputy warden would be entitled to \$4.00, and that the balance belongs to your Court or the County.

Section 12 of R. S. Chapter 38, indicates that an Inland Fish and Game Warden and Deputy Warden are entitled to the same fees as sheriffs.

In response to your letter of August 9, I am pleased to inform you that it appears to me that you are right in your contention that the seven cents per mile applies only to deputy wardens who are on special duty acting under orders of the sheriff.
