Gentlement

Replying to your letter of March 6 concerning the mirrors used on trucks in the State of Laine, I am clearly of the opinion that the face of the mirror must be six inches in diameter. That is to say that that part of the cirror which is exposed and usable for the purpose of obtaining a view to the rear of the car must be six inches in diameter.

I am sorry if this opinion interferes at all with the mirror you now have but I know of no other way of interpreting the law.
