I am pleased to acknowledge receipt of your inquiry of May 10. You ask, Can a license be transferred, and if so, does the state contract permit a transfer from one part of the state to another? My answer is, No.

You also ask, Can beer be brought into a restaurant and consumed there if the restaurant is not licensed? My answer is, Yes. Provided, however, that the person in possession of the beer serves and consumes the beer himself with his food.
