Dear Siri

While I cannot give you am official opinion regarding your communication of May 1, owing to the fact that it is a matter wholly among different boards in the town, and in case of disagreement between the municipal officers and the school board could only be settled by the courts. I am pleased to call your attention to Section 18 of Chapter 19, of the Revised Statutes which seems to indicate that the municipal officers may demand a bill of items which has been approved by a majority of the members of the Superintending School Committee; and certified by the Superintendent of Schools.
