Replying to your inquiry of July 20, I beg to advise that in my opinion Canadian fishermen are entitled to the same refund as citizens of Maine on gasoline sold to the fishermen off the coast of Maine. The law itself makes no exception, and even if it did I seriously doubt the validity of such an exception.
