The Attorney General was here yesterday and I went over the matter of the Grone bridge with him at come length, and he is of the opinion that it was not the intention of the legislature, by the enactment of Chap. 35, P.L.1351 and Chap. 157,P.L. 1933, to relieve the public utility from its obligations already assumed by it in the use of bridges on state highways.

would require the state, in the construction of new bridges on state highways, to provide for their use by the public utility in the absence of some enactment or agreement.
