Dear Mr. Levis

In response to your letter of July 12, I am pleased to call your attention to fection 1 of Chapter 54, P. L. 1958, which provides that,

There is hereby imposed on excise tax of 10 sents per pound on all elecatrgarine sold, offered or exposed for sele, or exchanged in the State of Maine containing any fat, etc.

While the matter is not wholly free from doubt, it seems to me that, with these provisions of the law, marghride shipped in interstate commerce is not subject to this tax. The law does not appear to relate to the manufacture of margatime, but only to transactions regarding disposition of same within the state.
