To Elmer W. Campbell, Chief Clerk, State Board of Barbers  
Re: Operation in a Beauty Parlor

After reviewing Section 17 of Chapter 112 of the Public Laws of 1935, which amends Chapter 282, Public Laws of 1933, it is my opinion that a barber acting entirely within the scope of the profession of barbering, may carry on such practice in connection with a beauty parlor, without being subject to registration requirements required of beauty parlor operators.
