Dear Brother Murchie:

I have talked with the Attorney General about the matter you submitted to me the other day relative to what constitutes a semi-trailer and both the General and Mr. Barrows, the Secretary of State, agree with me that the fact that the poles you mention being hauled behind a truck on a trailer, resting in part on the truck, does not constitute a semi-trailer within the meaning of the law.

Mr. Barrows has not had any information relative to the arrest of the man you mention.
