Answering your inquiry as to the legality of thirty-three (33) notes aggregating Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000), issued by the State of Maine, dated September 4, 1935, payable June 4, 1936, this department makes the following reply:

These notes, all of which I have examined, are issued by authorization of an Order passed by the Council and by the Governor approved on the fourth day of September, 1935.

The issuance of these notes, being authorized by law and all proceedings in connection therewith being regular, is legal and is a pledge of the faith and credit, and is a general obligation of the State of Maine.
