Dear Sirt.

While I cannot give you an official opinion regarding the construction of Section 12 of Chapter 7, R. S., relative to the right of voters enrolling for the first time to vote in the Frimary, I am pleased, informally and unofficially, to express as my opinion that the exception stated in the last three lines of said section, takes the voter enrolling for the first time in the municipality, out of the preceding requirements and prohibitions of said section so that said new voter has the same rights of registration and enrollment as does a new voter enrolling for the first time.

It seems to me that any other construction of the statute would deprive many qualified voters of the right to participate in the Primary election.
