Answering your inquiry as to the legality of the foregoing issue and sale of State Highway and Bridge Bonds, this department makes the following reply:

This issue and sale of State Highway and Bridge Bonds to the amount of One Million Five Hundred Thousand (\$1,500,000) Dollars, being duly authorized by the constitution and acts of the legislature, and all other proceedings in connection therewith being regular, these bonds, in my opinion, are a general obligation of the State of Maine, payable from unlimited ad valorem taxes to be levied on all the taxable property therein.
