Answering your inquiry as to the legality of the foregoing issue and sale of State Highway and Bridge Bonds, this department makes the following replys

This issue and sale of State Highway and Bridge Bonds to the amount of One Million Five Hundred Thousand (\$1,500,000) Dollars, being duly authorized by the constitution and acts of the legislature, and all other proceedings in connection therewith being regular, these bonds, in my opinion, are a general obligation of the State of Maine, payable from unlimited ad valoren taxes to be levied on all the taxable property therein.
