Answering your inquiry as to the legality of twenty (20) Notes aggregating Two Million (\$2,000,000) Dollars, issued by the State of Maine, Dated November 6, 1936, Payable June 4, 1937, this department makes the following reply:

These notes, all of which I have examined, are issued under the authority of an Order of the State Council and by the Governor approved on the 6th day of November, 1936.

The issuance of these notes, being duly authorized and all proceedings in connection therewith being regular, is a pledge of the faith and credit and is a general obligation of the State of Maine.
