On September 15, you entered into an agreement with Mr. L. S. Owen the State Purchasing Agent, to sell and deliver to the State Purchasing Department Four Thousand (4000) bushels of potatoes.

Demand is hereby made for the immediate delivery by you to the State Purchasing Department of the remaining Nineteen Hundred (1900) bushels in accordance with the terms of your contract.
