Dear Mr. Barrows:

In response to your letter of March 16, relative to State of Maine, in cooperation with the State of New Hampshire and the U. S. Geological Survey establishment of the boundary line between New Hampshire and Maine, I am pleased to suggest that we have compared the Maine and New Hampshire Acts, and find that they may be considered sufficiently similar to carry out the evident intention of the Legislature.

We do not think any amendment on the part of the State of New Hampshire Legislature is required as it does not appear to us to invalidate in any way the Maine Act.

I am enclosing Legislative Document No. 16, and the photostatic copy of the New Hampshire Act, together with the Commissioner's letter.
