Dear Brother Smalley:

In response to your letter of June 8, addressed to the Forest Commissioner, I am enclosing copy of Section 57 of Chapter 11, Revised Statutes, relating to portable saw-mills. This has printed at the bottom the definition of a portable sawmill which is, in effect, the meaning of the term as construed by the Forest Commissioner; and which is, I am informed, the definition given the Commissioner by the Attorney General's department sometime in the past and which seems to apply to Mr. Archibald's mill.

I think Commissioner Seavey does not desire to cause Mr. Archibald any unnecessary burden but feels that it is his duty to enforce what appears to me to be the requirements of the statute.
