Mr. A. E. Lewis, your chief clerk, has inquired relative to whether or not the National Association of Audubon Societies can qualify under the provisions of Paragraph 3, Section 6, Chapter 18 of the Revised Statutes, for exemption from taxation of property owned by the society in this state.

In answer to this inquiry I have to inform you that I do not find in said paragraph or in any other section of our statutes, any provision which appears to authorize such exemption.
