To the Advisory Committee on Personnel  
Maine Unemployment Compensation Commission  
Augusta, Maine

I have just discussed the provisions of Section 8, Rule VI of the Regulations for Merit System and Personnel Administration in the Maine Unemployment Compensation Commission with Professor Hornell, and it is my opinion that the provisions of this section which state that: "Applicants must be ~~\*\*\*\*\*~~ legal residents of the State of Maine for at least one year prior to the date of application", requires that any applicant at the time of his application must be a legal resident of the State of Maine and must have been such legal resident for at least one continuous year just prior to the date of making application.
