Gentlemen:

I am enclosing copy of an Order passed by the Governor and Council of the State of Maine on January 21, 1938.

This Order puts into effect generally in all the State departments a method of handling the work of the Bureau of Accounts and Control which has been in effect for certain of the State departments for a period of six years and which, in the opinion of the Governor and Council, will distribute equitably over the various departments the expense of operating that Bureau.

In my opinion the Governor and Council have the necessary authority to pass this Order, and the provisions of it are legal and binding upon all State departments.
