To Officer Thibedeau, Maine State Police
Re: Warrants - Truck Violations

. . . My answer to your inquiry is that in my opinion the warrant for the arrest should be against the operator of the truck.

It seems to me that the statute does not require the prosecuting officer to ascertain in each individual case who the owner of the truck may be.
