Dear Mr. Cummings:

I have conferred with Mr. Robie, the Secretary of State, concerning the points raised in your letter of May 12, having to do with the use of safety glass in motor vehicles. Our understanding of the law of 1937, which you quote, corresponds to yours as stated in your letter.

Mr. Robie tells me that he has approved certain makes of glass which can be used in compliance with the law, and also tells me that he will ask one of the inspectors connected with his department to call on you in the very near future, and I trust you will be willing to disclose to him what you know about any person who is not complying with the Act.
