Dear Sir: Re: Deer Isle-Sedgwick Bridge District.

Answering your recent oral inquiry as to the effect of the enactment by the 89th Legislature, being Chapter 20 of the Private and Special Laws of 1939, whereby section 9 of Chapter 88 of the Private and Special Laws of 1935 was repealed, and especially as to the obligation of the State of Maine under said Chapter 68, wherein it was provided that:

\*... any additional funds necessary for maintenance, interest and the retirement of bonds shall be furnished and paid by the state of Maine.\*

I am pleased to inform you that the repeal of said act in no wise affects the obligations of the State to carry out its pleage made prior to said repeal.

In other words, the State is not relieved from its obligations existing prior to said repeal.
