You wrote me on September 29th asking whether or not in my opinion representatives of foreign governments are entitled to exemption or refund of the State tax on gasoline.

I do not know of any grounds on which such exemption would be justified in this State, and I think you should properly refuse to grant any such claim in the absence of express statutory provisions.
