Dear Mr. Bates

Esrewith I am hending you two indictments in final form against William A. Runnells; one contains eighty-four separate counts and alleges a larceny in the aggregate amount of \$50,864.94,- and the other alleges a larceny in the sum of \$26,420.00. It has been considered, as you know, that these indictments meet all mesded present requirements.

Anticipating your kind cooperation, the Governor, the Attorney General and I desire that when the indictments have been returned to Court a capies be requested forthwith for the errest of Mr. Runnells who is now under guard at the hospital as you are sware. I will report to you here that his physical condition is such, I am informed by Dr. Roland L. McKey who has recently examined him, that his immediate arrest will not endanger him nor retard his recovery.
