Gentlemen:

In answer to your inquiry relative to license fees required to be paid by a partnership and its members under the provisions of Section 7, Chapter 83, Public Laws of 1937, I am pleased to inform you that a partnership pays an original license fee of \$10, and a renewal fee of \$5 which permits the partnership and one of its members to be designated by it to operate as a real estate broker. Other members of the partnership who now hold a broker's license are entitled to a renewal thereof by paying the usual renewal license fee of \$5.
