Dear Sirs:

Mr. F. P. Washburn, Commissioner of Agriculture has sent me your letter about exemption from taxation of certain lands, and requested me to rule on your question.

Mr. Washburn evidently misunderstood your early inquiry and connected it with Auxiliary State Forests which were exempted from taxation by Chapter 306 of the Public Laws of 1929, afterwards being Sections 82 to 89 of Chapter 11, Revised Statutes of 1930. These sections were all repealed by Chapter 139 of the Public Laws of 1933.

Evidently the statute to which you referred is Paragraph XI of Section 6 of Chapter 13, Revised Statutes of 1930, which was enacted by Chapter 247, Public Laws of 1927, which is still in force.
