In re City of Eastport

In accordance with the interpretation which I have placed upon Section 101 of Chapter 5 of the Revised Statutes in another memorandum to you of this date, it is my feeling that the charge which you have on your books against the City of Eastport for the expense incurred by the State in making an audit of the financial affairs of that city, is a valid claim against the city and should be added to the other amounts owed by that city to the State, and when the time comes to prove claims it should be included with the taxes and other items of indebtedness which the State is entitled to receive.
