Dear Sir:

I have your letter of February 7th, asking for a written opinion on the matter of the Order passed by the city government of the City of Waterville. The Attorney General's office is not permitted to give opinions on matters of this nature. However, for your information, I have discussed this particular thing with the head of the school department, Mr. Packerd, and as the result of our conversation it is my understanding that he has told the officials of a certain town that he knows of no objection to their including in their appropriations an amount for a conveyance of children to parochial schools, although it should not be set up in their school budget.
