Will you kindly bring to the attention of your committee that I have made an arrangement for the Attorney General's office with the Director of the Bureau of Public Health, Dr. Mitchell under the terms of which I am to have the use of Dr. Morrell as pathologist whenever I want him for that kind of work. I am to pay the Health Department \$300 per year.

This \$300 is to be added to Dr. Morrell's salary by the Health Department so that you should consider adding \$300 to the appropriation for the Attorney General's department and making no deduction from the appropriation for the Health Department.

I am convinced that through this arrangement I can save the State of Maine several hundred dollars a year on the services of pathologists.
