To Henry P. Weaver Chief, Maine State Police
Re: Effective Date of Salary Increases

I have your letter in regard to the date at which increases in pay shall be made to members of the State Police.

Inasmuch as Chapter 272 of the Public Laws of 1939 took effect on April 20th, that should be considered as the base date for the beginning of pay of police officers, and the annual increases should begin on April 21st of each year.
