Dear Sir:

I have your letter of April 23rd, asking whether or not the Home Guard law repealed Sections 91 to 102 of the Military Law of Maine.

Until the Home Guard act was passed there were no sections higher than 90 in the military law. The booklet entitled: "Military Law of the State of Maine, Chapter 18, 1940" contains very serious errors. The sections numbered 91, 92, 93, 94, for instance, should be properly numbered R. S. Chapter 5, sections 72, 73, 74 and 75.

Section numbered 95 should be properly numbered R. S. Chapter 31, section 15.

Sections numbered 96 and 97 should be properly numbered R. S. Chapter 134, sections 21 and 22.

I have not checked through the sections numbered in the booklet, 98 to 102, inclusive, but they all erroneously numbered.

I am returning to you herewith the copy of the booklet which you sent to me with corrections as I have suggested above.
