I have your letter of May 2nd in regard to Inspector William E. Gibson. I believe the second of your suggested methods of procedure is the best. The Governor and Council certainly have the power to approve the Inspector's retirement in June of this year, the pension to take effect at a later date, provided the Inspector consents to such postponement.

His consent should, however, be in writing so that no question will ever be raised in regard to the reason for handling the thing in that manner.
