In response to your letter of June 6th, relative to Minimum Premium Tax on foreign insurance companies, I am pleased to inform you that we are of the opinion that the tax assessed for 1940, being assessed on April 1st, 1941 and payable May 1st, should be paid.

We do not believe that the repeal of the law on April 30th, 1941, 30 days after the tax had been assessed, would be a valid reason to refuse payment.
